PREPARATION: All campers must bring their own CAMP equipment, including...

GUIDELINES & REGULATIONS

- A <u>completed</u> Registration Form, including contact information of parents and emergency contact must be on file before the cub scout can participate in the camping event. Pack 88 will provide a First Aid Kit at the Campsite.
- Cub Scout Camping_is a family event. **Each scout must be accompanied by at least one parent** for the duration of the event. Parents and siblings are invited to attend, and parents are required to monitor the siblings **at all times**. Cub Scout Leaders will be occupied with cub scout activities at the campsite. There will be **no childcare for siblings** at the Camp.
- It is required by BSA that **one parent sleep with their cub scout** and <u>no child may sleep in a tent with another adult</u>. Two (non-sibling) AOL scouts may sleep in one tent, with no adult in that tent, provided permission granted by their parents.
- The **buddy system** is to be used for cub scouts when moving around the campsite. No cub scout is to leave the campsite without their buddy and acknowledgment from Den Leaders or Parents.
- No cub scouts/siblings/buddies should travel outside of **visual contact** of the campsite unless accompanied by an adult.
- **No running or horse play** will be allowed in the **food prep or tent areas**. Designated areas will be announced for physical activities.
- No cub scout/sibling may participate in the **cooking of food or meals** over an **open fire**, without <u>direct adult supervision</u> and must be a requirement for a Badge. The exception to this is roasting marshmallows at the campfire which will be supervised by parents and leaders.
- **No alcoholic beverages** are allowed at the campsite.
- For maximum enjoyment and to insure this is a rewarding experience it is requested that **every adult help maintain and support these guidelines at all times** during the event. It takes a village...
